CONCLUSION OF THE PROJECT

During the two project periods (1.2.-30.6.2015 a 1.7.2015-30.6.2016) we met the determined goals of the project by setting a close contact and cooperation between the academics from the Faculty of Sports Studies (Brno, CZ) and University of Vienna (AT) and by implementation of two intensive schools for students and young researcherch of both above mentioned institutions. We also succeeded to conduct a socio-psychological background research by means of a questionnaire data collection of seniors from CZ and AT, focusing on the physical activity and type in their childhood as well as their contemporary situation in the area of spending time together with their grandchildren and doing physical activities. Preliminary results of the research were presented at the international conference *Sport and Quality of Life* in Brno in 11/2015. However, the complex results of the research shall be published in scientific journals in the following months. The academics of both institutions are going to continue their cooperation and their further goal is to conduct research inquiry with children, focusing on their view of their grandparents. Specifics of both countries will be taken into consideration again. The financial support received by AKTION programme was used economically in order to meet the project goals.



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
