Radiology English Across Borders - Final report 2024

Joint Workshop of Fachhochschule Wiener Neustadt and Palacký University Olomouc, Czech Republic

Similarly to the previous year, the workshop was designed for six students from each participating institution. Students were selected based on their willingness to participate and level of English as assessed by their language instructors. The workshop was divided into a pre-session (home assignment) and two physical parts taking place in Olomouc and Wiener Neustadt. The number was limited to the size of the simulation room at FHS.

The activities carried out are listed below according to the programme.

Olomouc part:

Thursday 3 October 2024

Arrival by train from Wiener Neustadt to Olomouc. Students participants were accommodated in the Hotel Flora and the lecturers stayed at the Hotel Arigone.

Friday 4 October 2024

Session 1: start 9:00 (120 minutes) Room 2.054

- Introduction of programme, welcome speech.
- Warm-up activity (getting to know each other, quiz)
- Professional communication: developing professional competence.
- 11:00 13:00 Tour of the University Hospital Olomouc: Radiology Clinic talk and tour. A walk-through PET/CT, PET examination, MRI and Department of Radiation Oncology. The tour was guided by colleagues from the University Hospital Olomouc.
