


CASS2019 Feedback


The following report summarizes the most important information from the online feedback submitted by the participants after CASS2019 took place.

How likely is it that you would recommend the Summer School to a colleague or friend? How was the main topic of the Summer School?





What was the quality of the lecturers?





Overall, how would you rate the event?



How organized was the event?




- Extremely organized



Was the event length long or short?




- Much too long



How was the quality of the food?




- Excellent
