On 12th October, 2017, an interactive seminar took place at the Institute of Foreign Languages, Faculty of Education, Palacký University Olomouc, under the terms of Aktion-Project 79p2.

Professor Haupt arrived in Olomouc by train on Wednesday afternoon and moved in the university hostel for visiting professors, Vančurova, where he stayed for 2 nights.

On Thursday morning, all the participants met at the Institute of Foreign Languages.

The seminar started with a welcome speech by **Dr. Anténe** who then proceeded to give his lecture **Future Foreign Language Teachers in the Czech Republic and Their Favourite American Books**, based on the results of a questionnaire handed in to students of the English and German section of the Institute of Foreign Languages.

The following lectures were by **Doc. Řeřicha: Successive Borrowings from American English in Czech**, **Prof. Haupt: Advantages or Disadvantages of Early English Learning in Austria**, and **Dr. Kořínková: Perception of America in Czech So-called "Tramp" Songs**.

Lunch for the presenters was provided at the restaurant Bistrá kráva.

The afternoon program consisted of lectures by **Dr. Hoffmannová: American Drama** on Czech Stage: the Contemporary Point of View, Dr. Hrdinová, "Karl May's America" – an Interesting Cultural and Literary Construct, Dr. Práger: America in Contemporary British Literature, and Mgr. Kovářová: Perception of American Culture in the Works of Contemporary American Authors.

The audience at the seminar included other internal and external members of the Institute of Foreign Languages (Mgr. Linda Chmelařová, Ph.D., Mgr. Ruth Valentová, Ph.D., Mgr. Marek Bohuš, Ph.D., Shauna O'Brien, Ph.D), and Ph.D. students of Pedagogy (Mgr. Jan Gregar).

Dinner for the presenters was provided at the restaurant Konvikt.

On Friday morning before Professor Haupt's departure, the presenters met at the Institute of Foreign Languages again to discuss the details of the collective monograph *"Route CZ-AT" to the USA: Perceiving American Culture in Central Europe* that will consist of extended versions of their lectures (to be published by Palacký University in 2018).
