

## Report of Vienna

We spent 5 days in Vienna. We were at BOKU University. We spent 3 days in laboratory at BOKU, where we investigated 3 experiments on rill erosion:

- Mini flume experiment
- Splash erosion experiment with rainfall simulator
- Determination of aggregate stability

Last day we calculated data and discussed the results.

On the third day, we took part in excursion to 2 high schools in Austria. First one was in Tulln and second one was in Hollabrunn. At the first high school we were shown a presentation about types of tillage. We saw seeding machine that has more functions, so it reduces cost as fuel and time. At the second high school we heard a lecture about agriculture techniques and tillage. Then we saw the demonstration of different intercrop control methods. The final stage of our excursion was tasting of local wines.

In Vienna we also had time for a walk through the center, tasting local specialties such as “wiener schnitzel” or “sacher-torte” and We were to visit some monuments.
